DANGERS FOR WOMEN IN THE DARK



For many years it has been unsafe for women to do regular things like walking alone at night or even leaving their drink unattended at a party. The murder and rape of Sarah Everard has made woman more conscious of this issue.

Sarah Everard was a 33 year old woman who was brought to a place near Dover and murdered by police officer Wayne Couzens, after walking late at night. 20% of women and 4% of men have experienced some type of sexual assault since the age of 16

equivalent to 3.4 million female and 631,000 male victims. 83 woman are suspected to have been murdered since the start of the year. This case has brough attention to a very important issue and is worrying more people as it getting darker earlier.


Number 2:


October Reads!


