Points to Note

1. You should wear normal school uniform throughout the assessment week – it is a school week.
2. There are **two** assessments each day.  
On long days (Mon/Tues/Thurs) there will be one assessment over Per 1 & 2 and then another assessment over Period 6 & 7.  
On a short day (Wed/Friday), there will be one assessment over Per 1 & 2 and another one over Per 4 & 5. Please note this applies only to Friday 11<sup>th</sup> February (as there is only one assessment on Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> February).
3. At the beginning of each assessment period go to your usual timetabled class. Your class teacher will take registration and then escort the class to the assessment rooms.
4. When you are not in an assessment, you will be revising in class or undertaking private study. Make sure you have materials/notes to revise with you. This also applies at the end of each assessment. Where an assessment finishes before the end of the double period, you will be given time to continue with some revision.
5. You are responsible for your revision – you should have a study plan to help you to use your time effectively.
6. Make sure you bring all necessary equipment each day – pens, pencils, rubber, ruler and a calculator.
7. You can bring water into the assessment room BUT **no** food.
8. Please read the schedule carefully and speak to Ms Robertson if there are any issues.

### **On the day of the assessment**

1. Remember, to go to your usual timetabled class at the beginning of each assessment block.
2. You should bring all belongings to the assessment room including bags and jackets. Put any jackets over the chair and your bag under the chair.
3. Before you enter the assessment room ensure that your mobile phone is turned off and in your bag. The mobile phone must be off and out of sight at all times.
4. You should enter the assessment rooms quietly and listen carefully to any instructions given by staff.
5. Talking during an assessment is not allowed, unless you need to speak to a member of staff.
6. Should you arrive late for an assessment (after the assessment has started), you will not be given any extra time.
7. Should you feel unwell during an assessment, please put your hand up and let us know.
8. Should you misbehave during an assessment, you will be removed from the room.
9. You will remain in the room until the end of the assessment block. Time permitting, you can undertake some silent revision for any further assessments

P 1 and 2 Sit the assessment for period 1 subject

P 6 and 7 Sit the assessment for period 6 subject

**Wednesday 16th February**

P 1 and 2 Sit the assessment for period 1 subject
