







- Adjusted/Widening Access the grades required if you fall under certain criteria that put you at a disadvantage already
- Different information/language used in each university

Demonstrates "super curricular" interest

Early Applications

- 6th Sept Personal Statement deadline
- ▶ 20th September on-line form completed
- ➤ 23-26 September 1-1 Guidance interviews
- ▶ 4 October last day for GT to submit paperwork to head teacher

Regular Applications

- 1st October Personal Statement drafts to GTs
- Oct/Nov 1-1 Guidance interviews
- ▶ 1 November on-line form completed
- 1 December Guidance interviews complete
- ▶ 8 December Last day for pay and send
- ▶ 11 December Last day for GT to submit paperwork to head teacher





Interview/Supplementary Testing

Many courses now interview

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 Mock interviews available – see Miss Munro to arrange

Supplementary tests eg LNAT, UCAT ...
or a portfolio may be
required. Research is important.



Support Moving Forward

- Hand in personal statement
- Pupils meet 1-1 with their guidance teacher to ensure form is accurate and as strong as can be
- Pupil makes final corrections
- Pupil review and submit (pay/send) form this comes to school
- Guidance teacher writes reference
- Mr Paterson reviews application and reference
- Office staff do final clerical check, verified and send form to UCAS – a month ahead of national deadline

Offers

- Some offers will come in very quickly
- All applications made by the course deadline (25th Jan) will be given equal consideration
- Potential worries about not getting an offer – places are not allocated on a first come first served basis
- When offers are in, they need to make a decision around the start of June
