

Swimming

Duncan McKinney, S4, competed at the International Children's Games held in Holland in June. He qualified for the finals in all 4 of his events and was the highest placed Scottish Swimmer.

He finished 4th in the 400m freestyle and 200m backstroke, 5th in 50m backstroke and 6th in the 200m freestyle.

In July he competed at the Scottish summer meet where he won 3 gold medals (200m, 400m freestyle and 200m individual medley) and one silver medal (200m backstroke).

In August he received notification that he has been selected, for the second time, to the Scottish Youth Development Squad.

Another year of hard work is ahead of Duncan combining swimming practice with studying for nine National 5 exams. We wish him well.
