S4 Courses

- •Reducing from current subjects to 7 subjects plus Core subjects (PSE, RMPS & PE)
- English & Maths must continue
- •Choice must carry forward seven of the subjects undertaken in S3 (no new subjects can be chosen) Exception to this is Early Learning and Childcare and Media
- •Each course has 4 periods allocated. This includes one double period.
- Core Subjects -5 periods (includes 1PSE, 3 PE, 1 RMPS)

S5 and Beyond

- Many will be expected to progress to Higher.
- Some may choose to study additional National 5's
- •In S6, there is the option to add to qualifications by choosing to study further at Advanced Higher or selecting alternative Higher /National 5 courses.
- •Pupils can crash Higher courses in S6.
- •They may also access the EDC Senior Phase Vocational programme.





