**Members of Youth Organisations and their Leaders.** Working towards a badge for citizenship or similar which deals with equality and sustainability issues? Ask us for help to source the material you require.

**Parents and anyone else looking to incorporate more Fair Trade ingredients into their meal planning.** We can help you locate suppliers and even provide some recipe cards.
